Acer buergerianum

Trident Maple

Height: 20'	Flower: inconspicuous
Spread: 20'	Fruit: insignificant
Shape: Upright, rounded	Foliage: glossy green
Zone: 5 - 8	Fall Foliage: red, orange

A good choice for confined sites and tough growing conditions. Tolerant of wind, salt, drought, air pollution, and soil compaction. Bark exfoliates with age revealing grey, orange, brown color.

Acer campestre

Hedge Maple

Height: 30'	Flower: inconspicuous
Spread: 30'	Fruit: 1 1/2", winged
Shape: dense, rounded	Foliage: dark green
Zone: 5 - 8	Fall Foliage: yellowish

A low maintenance tree that adapts well to urban settings. Attractive corky bark is striking in winter. A long-lived tree with a medium to slow growth rate.

Acer ginnala 'Flame'

Flame Maple

Height: 15'	Flower: yellowish-white
Spread: 15'	Fruit: red samara
Shape: small rounded	Foliage: green
Zone: 2 - 8	Fall Foliage: fiery red

A small, compact tree with brilliant red samaras in the summer. Slow growing. Very cold hardy. Tolerates dry and alkaline soils. Recommended street tree for under utility lines, between streets and sidewalks.

Acer griseum

Paperbark Maple

Shape: upright/oval	Foliage: medium green
Zone: 4 - 8	Fall Foliage: red

A beautiful small tree. Its exfoliating orange cinnamon colored bark creates a tree with year round interest. Adaptable to acid or alkaline soils. Needs good drainage.

Acer miyabei ‘Morton’

State Street Maple

A Morton Arboretum release with dark green foliage and interesting dark gray corky bark. Excellent ornamental character, very tolerant of heat, drought, salt and pollution. This tree shows no signs of insect or disease problems and can be used as a shade or street tree

Acer platanoides ‘Columnar’

Columnar Norway Maple

Narrow upright and compact makes this tree perfect for street use where buildings demand a narrow tree. Branches grow stiffly upward, almost parallel to the main stem, which gives it a bold appearance in winter.

Acer platanoides ‘Crimson King’

This cultivar has an improved columnar form with brighter foliage color, greater density and less leggy growth habit. This tree can be used for narrow street planting sites.

Acer rubrum ‘October Glory’

October Glory Maple

Dense rounded form. Colors change with weather conditions. Holds leaves late for extended color. Very popular selection due to fall color display.

Acer rubrum 'Franksred'

Retains its brilliant red autumn color longer than most other varieties. Upright dense branching habit makes this an excellent street and lawn tree.

This tree has a straight and dominant central leader, strong branch angles and has a fast growth rate normally found in Acer freemanii.

A rapid growing sugar maple that branches well as a young tree and develops good caliper.

Crimson Sunset Maple

Heat tolerance is the distinguishing characteristic of this Acer truncatum hybrid. This tree resembles Crimson King, but is more upright and compact. It flourishes in the summer heat where few purple leafed plants will grow.

Fast growing narrow form makes it a good street tree or a good accent to a building. Yellow orange fall color.

Autumn Blaze Maple

This silver-red cross has all the vigor of a silver maple with a slightly smaller leaf, but not the narrow branch angles that cause wind breakage.

Outstanding compact tree with an upright habit and uniform growth. Has strong crotch angles. The dense foliage is disease resistant. Fall color is red turning to gold.

Aesculus x carnea ‘Ft. McNair’

Ft. McNair Red Horsechestnut

This selection blooms in late spring and foliage remains dark green until leaf drop.

Aesculus x arnoldiana ‘Autumn Splendor’

Autumn Splendor Buckeye

Shape: dense, rounded	Foliage: dark green
Zone: 4	Fall Foliage: maroon-red

This is a dense rounded tree that is small to medium sized and will fit well into most urban landscapes. Dark green shiny leaves appear to be scorch resistant and turn vivid maroon-red in fall. Prefers moist fertile soils and has no serious pest problems.

Aesculus octandra ‘Yellow Buckeye’

Yellow Buckeye Tree

Prefers moist well drained soil but tolerates dry conditions. Yellow flower spikes appear in late May and leaves turn to orange in fall.

The upright to gently spreading habit of this twenty foot plant makes it ideal for small areas.

This tree has a dominant central leader, upward scaffold branches and pure white blooms. It has healthy medium green foliage in summer that turns orange in the fall.

Amelanchier x laevis ‘Cumulus’

Cumulus Serviceberry

This upright selection produces an abundance of white flowers in early spring. Orange-red fall color. Minimal suckering makes it a suitable street tree.

Betula nigra 'Heritage'

Heritage River Birch

Creamy colored white bark that exfoliates. Highly resistant to bronze birch borer. Yellow fall color. Grows rapidly, once established.

Betula populifolia 'Whitespire'

This pyramidal shaped tree has chalk white bark, glossy dark green leaves that turn yellow in fall. Does well in poor soils. Salt tolerant. Birch borer resistant and has good resistance to leaf miners. Prefers full sun.

Carpinus betulus 'fastigiata'

An interesting umbrella shaped crown with a zigzagging trunk makes this a unique specimen.

A red leaved selection of Eastern Redbud. Deep rose purple flowers in May. Likes full sun for best color.

This compact form with attractive weeping purple leaves makes for an elegant landscape addition.

Skyline Locust

A broad pyramidal form, develops strong, sturdy trunk and shapely crown. Valuable for light shade.

Street Keeper Honeylocust

Shape: narrow, upright	Foliage: dark green
Zone: 4 - 7	Fall Foliage: yellow

An excellent tree for street plantings with its tight narrow form. The canopy is only half as wide as other cultivars and the foliage is deeper green than other selections.

Gleditsia triacanthos ‘Suncole’
Sunburst Honeylocust

Shape: pyramidal	Foliage: bright yellow tip growth

This selection has a medium growth rate with a broad pyramidal form. The new growth is always bright yellow, which contrasts attractively with the darker yellow green interior foliage.

Gymnocladus dioicus

Kentucky Coffee-Tree

This is a seedless selection with good tolerance of heat drought and cold. Doubly compound leaves give this tree a tropical feel.

Halesia Carolina 'JFS-PN2 Legacy'

Crushed Velvet Silverbell

This tree has a smaller leaf size, fine textured branching and velvety foliage to create a plush appearance. Grows in full sun to partial shade.

Hydrangea paniculata ‘Limelight’

Liquidambar styraciflua ‘Worplesdon’

This variety blooms much later than other Magnolias in late May and June. Attractive foliage and fragrant blooms makes this species an interesting ornamental. Tolerates moist conditions.

Irregularly spreading branches are smothered with bright pink flowers in spring.

Slow growing and forms a very dense, symmetrically rounded head. Its leaves are small and narrow, giving it a unique appearance.

This selection has large and fragrant double pink flowers. It is an excellent tree for lawn plantings because it has no fruit.

Pink buds open to large, white, double blooms. An excellent tree for use near utility lines, or courtyard settings.

Malus 'Jewelcole'

Red Jewel Crab

An upright pyramidal tree with single white blooms in spring. This tree hold its fruit throughout the winter for excellent color.

An outstanding crab with rosy blooms that is very fast growing. This is one of the best purple foliated crabs and has good disease resistance..

Malus 'Red Barron'

Red Barron Crab

Narrow columnar form when young. Single red blooms. Dark red fruit. Purple foliage fading to bronze green. Good disease resistance.

Malus 'Royal Raindrops'

Royal Raindrops Crab

Shape: upright spreading	Foliage: purple, cut-leaf
Zone: 4 - 8	

This tree has an upright spreading habit with bright pinkish-red blooms. It has purple cut-leaf foliage with persistent, 1/4" red fruit. Excellent disease resistance.

Malus 'Sargentii'

Sargent Crab

Spread: 12'	Fruit: 1/4", red
Shape: dwarf, spreading	Foliage: dark green
Zone: 3 - 8	

Low, spreading dwarf habit. White flowers, dark green foliage and bright scarlet-red fruit that persists into winter. Excellent disease resistance.

Malus sargent 'Tina'

Sargent Tina Crab
